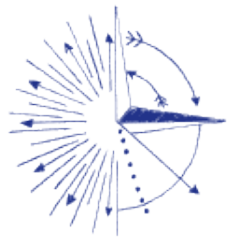

Do you have concerns about falling? *A Matter of Balance*, offered in conjunction with Allentown Health Bureau, helps older adults reduce their fears of falling by learning to view falls as controllable. The program will also set goals for increasing activity levels, encourage small changes to reduce fall risks at home, and demonstrate ways to exercise to increase strength and balance. The series consists of eight 2-hour sessions in the library's meeting room.
